


Government Expenses: \$18,652 per capita

## PEACE TAX SEMINAR 20<sup>th</sup> -22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019

\*These figures underestimate military spending from our taxes, because military spending comes from Vote Defence, Vote Defence Force, and Vote Education. Actual military spending from the 2018 budget increased to a record total of \$3,755,683,000.
